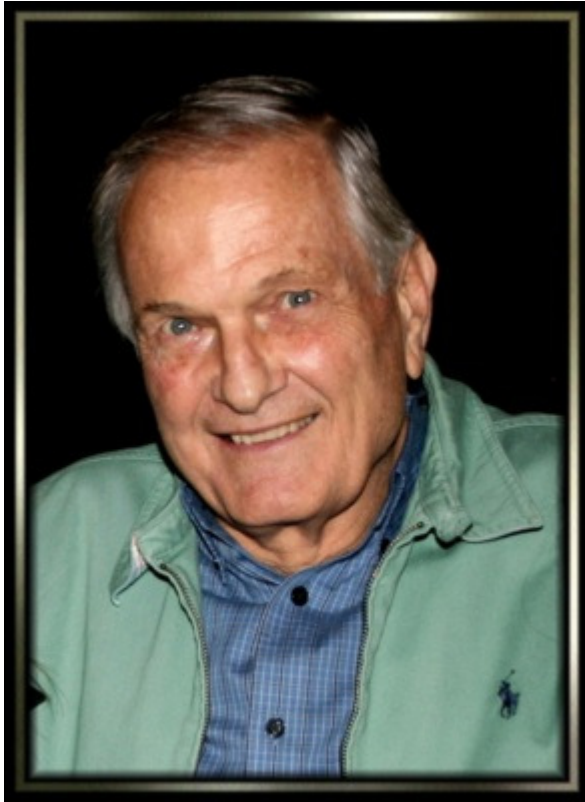


# Wesley Lynn Grigsby

Note from Stephen Baird: (a classmate) sent Thursday, July 8, 2010:

Wesley Grigsby died last night. His son called me to let me know. As you likely know, Wesley had a quadruple heart bypass a few years ago and had ongoing congestive heart failure. His doctors were always working to balance his prescription drugs together with his heart monitor so that he could lead a fairly normal life. He did that, although he was always less than 100%. Very recently, his heart stopped and his implanted device had to kick in to restart it. He momentarily passed out and didn't feel comfortable about driving after that. He was going through some tests and interviews to qualify to be placed on a heart transplant list. Unfortunately for all of us, he couldn't get a new heart before his damaged one gave out. Wesley handled his problems with much more grace and dignity than I will if I ever have to go through an extended period of serious illness. He continued to be as active as he could, given his circumstances - played tennis and ping pong to the end.
